- The final slate will be given to the Elections Committee Chair after the slate is presented to the Body during the 2nd Business Session on Wednesday, July 31, 2019; thus, completing the duties and responsibilities of the 2019 National Nominating Committee.

CAMPAIGNING GUIDELINES

- Candidates for election shall not campaign at any level (Chapter, Province or National Silhouettes) before the candidate's materials are posted on the National Silhouettes website, www.kappnationalsilhouettes.org on **June 1, 2019**.
- Candidates may purchase a campaign advertisement in the National Silhouettes Souvenir Journal after June 1, 2019 when all candidate's materials have been posted on the Silhouettes website.
- No campaign materials may be distributed inside the meeting room. Candidates may campaign outside the meeting room until 8:00 am (1st Business Session) and until 2:00pm (2nd Business Session) on Wednesday, July 31, 2019.
